

# Aquatic Centre

## Pool Rules

1. All users of the Aquatic Centre must follow the Pool Rules.
2. Public Swimmers are to follow the Royal Life Saving Australia's Keep Watch at Public Pools guidelines:
  - a. **0-5 years old and non-swimmers**  
Parent or guardian (adult) must be in the water within arm's reach of the child
  - b. **6-10 years old**  
Must be accompanied by a parent or guardian (adult) and must be in constant eye contact with the child
  - c. **11-14 years old**  
Recommended that parents check up on their child by physically going to the point where they are in or around the water
3. No diving in the centre.
4. Only centre staff and authorised contractors are permitted to conduct coaching or instruction at SGAC.
5. No jumping/bombing.
6. No running.
7. All patrons must wear appropriate swimwear. Streetwear or gym gear is not permitted. Any children who are not completely toilet trained must follow the 'Happy Nappy' policy.
8. No over-sized play toys, no rough play including pushing, sitting on lane ropes, obstructing lap swimmers, misuse of lane space with other swimmers, no squirt guns or push water toys.
9. No food or drink permitted in or around the pool edge.
10. No glass or sharp objects.
11. Pool equipment will not be hired out for use.
